

**MINISTER'S NOTICE TO  
PROCEED WITH TRANSIT PROJECT**

**Ontario Regulation 231/08**

**SUBSECTION 12(1)(a)**


RE: Proponent: Metrolinx

Project Description: The Union Station Rail Corridor East Enhancements project is for the addition of one new track on the north side, two new tracks on the south side, new tracks for the Wilson Yard Layover Facility and four bridge extensions, all within the eastern portion of the Union Station Rail Corridor, from Yonge Street easterly to Corktown Common Park, within the City of Toronto.

In accordance with subsection 12(1)(a) of Ontario Regulation 231/08, I hereby give notice allowing Metrolinx to proceed with the Union Station Rail Corridor East Enhancements transit project in accordance with the applicable environmental project report.

Metrolinx is now permitted to issue a statement of completion of the transit project assessment process. A statement of completion is the final part of the transit project assessment process. The process must be completed prior to the start of the construction phase of the project.
